Basic Requirements

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Eligible to work in Canada
- Ontario Secondary School Graduation Diploma or equivalent
- Up-to-date certification in Emergency First Aid, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

Selection Process

- Apply online to positions posted on the Ontario Public Service Career Portal – ontario.ca/jobs

Selected applicants must successfully complete each stage of the selection process:

- Ministry administered aptitude, cognitive ability and behavioural tests
- Fitness Test for Ontario Correctional Officer Applicants (FITCO)
- Enhanced security clearance process
- Interview and reference checks
- Pre-employment medical exam
- Correctional Officer Training and Assessment (COTA) program
