


Bonnechere Algonquin First Nation New Identification Card Form

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If possible please provide a photo approximately the size below and mail with this form to: Nancy Ward, 26 Locksley Road, Pembroke, ON, K8A 6W5

You are not required to submit a passport type photograph or a photograph that has been taken by a professional photographer. However your photograph must meet the following criteria:

- Show a full front view of your head and shoulders.
- Use a plain, contrasting background without shadows.
- Do not wear a hat or sunglasses. Your eyes should be clearly visible and should not appear to be red.
- The photo should have been taken within the last twelve (12) months.
- Size: the photo should be no larger than 45 mm x 57 mm (1 3/4" x 2 1/4"). Your head in the photograph must be at least 30 mm (1 3/16") high.
- The photo must be original, not taken from an existing photo.
- Digitally produced photos are acceptable provided all other requirements are met.
- Cut the image to fit the size requirements before sending it to us.

By now you should have received the Agreement In Principle (AIP) application and supporting information that has been made available to all persons who may be entitled to be enrolled as an Algonquin voter for the purpose of the upcoming ratification vote on the AIP for the Algonquin Land Claim. If you are aware of a member who will be 18 years of age on or before September 13, 2011 that has not yet received an AIP application, please call to notify us.

If your completed application form is not received by February 5, 2011 you will not be eligible to vote on the Agreement In Principle or in the ANR elections. Please complete and return the application ASAP.

If you require assistance to complete the application you have three options:

- 1) Attend our community information session on January 8 or January 22, 2011 at Algonquin College in Pembroke, both are on Saturdays at 10 am.
- 2) Contact one of our liaison support staff workers for assistance over the phone.
- 3) Request a private meeting with one of the liaison support staff workers or myself.

If you do not require assistance please complete the form and mail it back in the self addressed stamped envelope.
