## Potential Calabogie Redevelopment

Are you interested in construction related employment opportunities planned for the near future? Come out and learn more.

Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) is proposing to redevelop the existing Calabogie Generating Station (GS) located in Calabogie, Ontario. The 100 year old existing Calabogie GS is reaching its end of life, and OPG is exploring options to redevelop the facility. This Project is subject to an environmental assessment for existing water power structures under provincial legislation.

As this Project proceeds through the environmental assessment process, OPG has hired an engineering and construction team, who will be responsible for designing and building the Project. As part of this process, OPG is also working closely with the Algonquins of Pikwakanagan First Nation (AOP) and the Algonquins of Ontario (AOO).

If you are interested in learning more about construction-related employment opportunities for this Project, we invite you to meet with representatives from OPG and Sullivan at this Job Fair. Additional information will also be shared about the Environmental Assessment process for this Project.

**OPG's representatives will be available to answer questions about OPG local employment opportunities, and other career opportunities with OPG related to the Calabogie Project.**

Sullivan will answer your questions about local employment opportunities and offer guidance on joining its construction team. Building Trade Unions have also been invited to participate and to answer your questions about how you can become a member.

Sullivan considers Building Trade Unions as valuable partners providing training, pensions and benefit plans to workers. These relationships will be leveraged to provide employment opportunities to members of the Algonquin communities.
